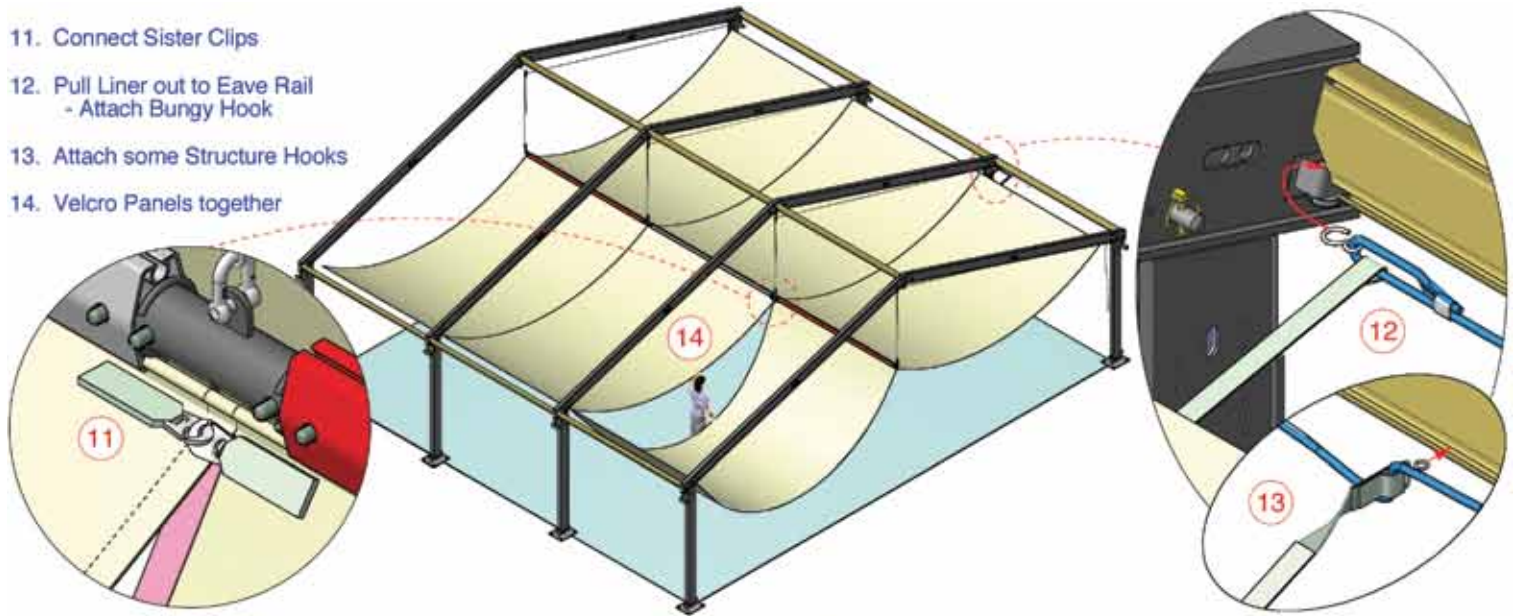

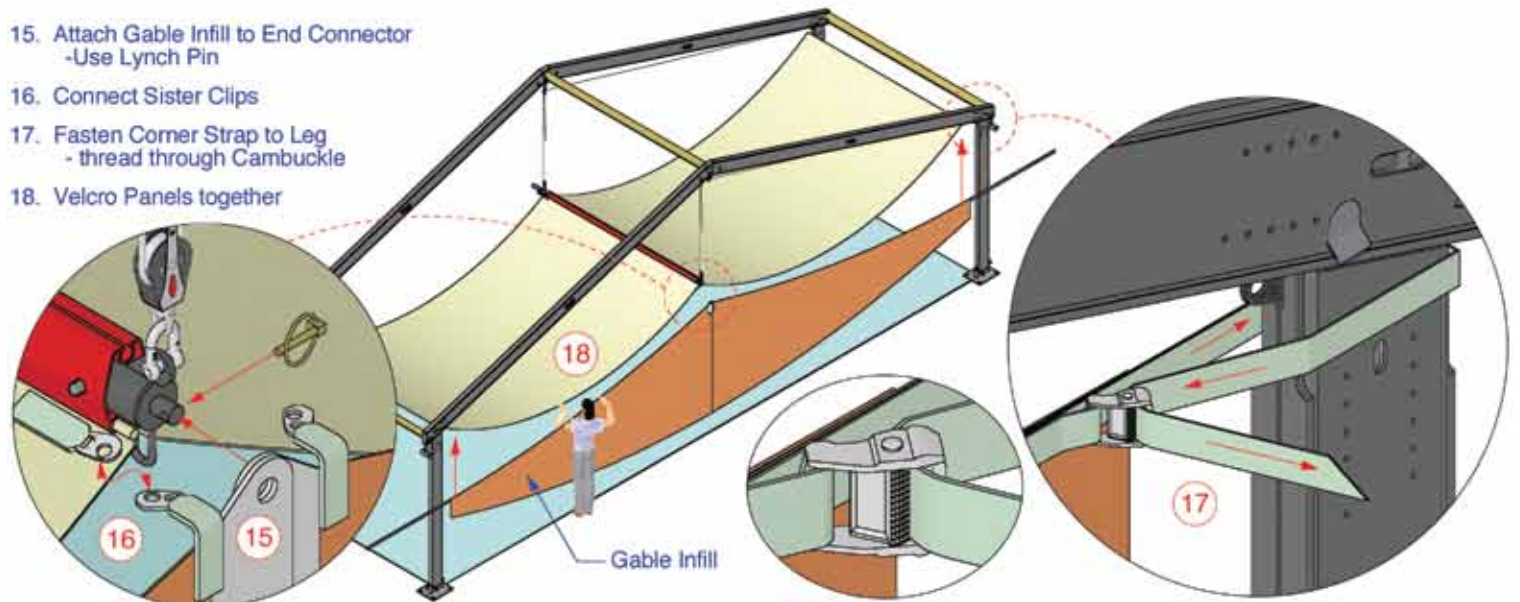

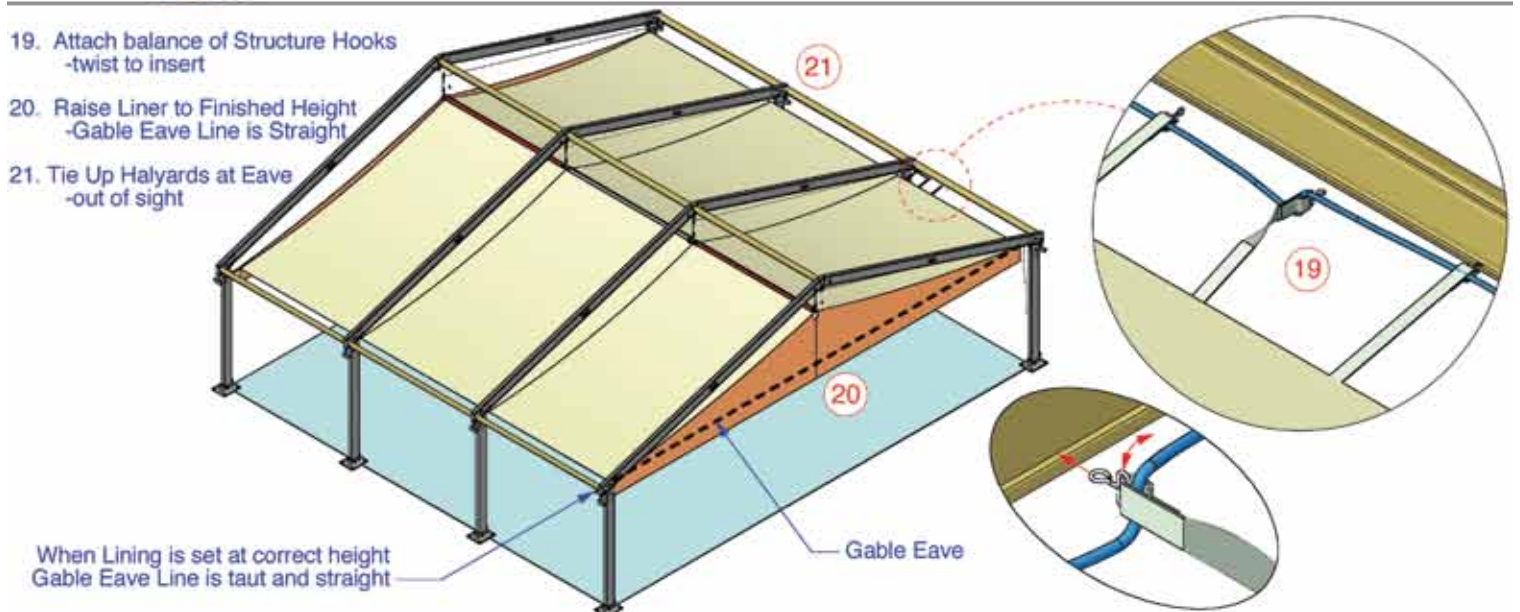
- 11. Connect Sister Clips
- 12. Pull Liner out to Eave Rail
- Attach Bungy Hook
- 13. Attach some Structure Hooks
- 14. Velcro Panels together



- 15. Attach Gable Infill to End Connector
-Use Lynch Pin
- 16. Connect Sister Clips
- 17. Fasten Corner Strap to Leg
- thread through Cambuckle
- 18. Velcro Panels together

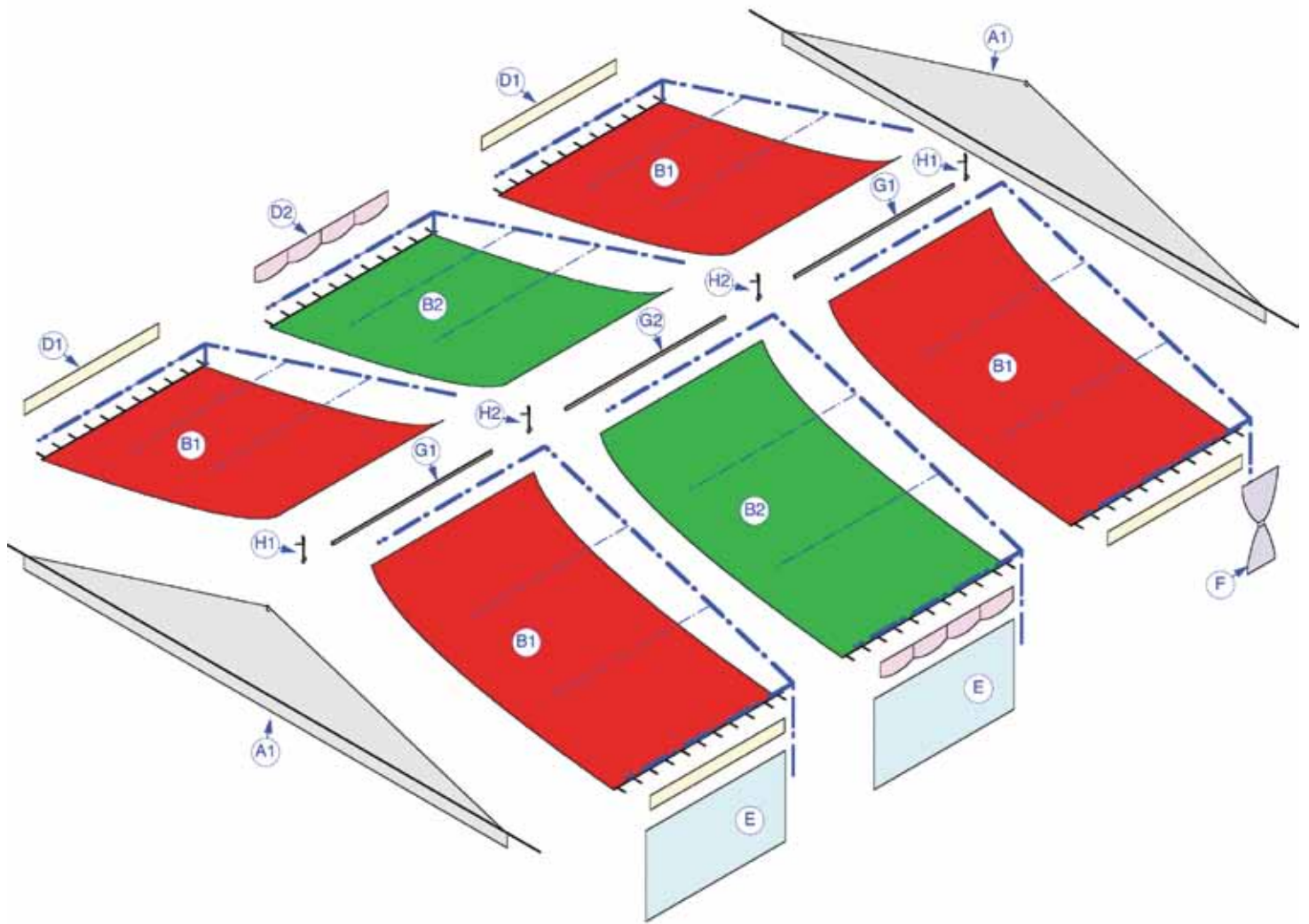


- 19. Attach balance of Structure Hooks
-twist to insert
- 20. Raise Liner to Finished Height
-Gable Eave Line is Straight
- 21. Tie Up Halyards at Eave
-out of sight



When Lining is set at correct height
Gable Eave Line is taut and straight
